## SELLING TOBACCO TO MINORS DOESN'T MAKE "CENTS."

**IN FACT, IT MAY COST YOU!**



Selling tobacco products is part of your job but it is against Connecticut law to sell tobacco to persons under the age of 18 years.

Clerks in violation will be fined **\$200** for the first offense, **\$350** for the second offense and **\$500** for the third offense.

To avoid illegal sales, routinely follow the

**"LOOK,  
SEE,  
CHECK ID"**

procedure whenever selling tobacco products.

# Look

**Look** at each person attempting to purchase a tobacco product.

# See

**See** if the person appears to be under age 27, if so request ID.

# Check ID

**Check photo ID** to determine if the person is under age 18.

No ID. No Sale. No Exceptions.
